

**LOCAL OPEN BURNING OFFICIAL

1. This is a valid permit only when signed by the Local Open Burning Official.
2. The permit does not relieve the permittee of any legal liability, which may be incurred as a result of the fire.
3. Failure to adhere to the conditions of the permit may result in penalties and/or other enforcement actions.

THIS PERMIT IS *NOT VALID*
UNDER THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

- When national or state ambient air quality standards may be exceeded;
- Where a hazardous health condition might be created;
- When the Air Quality Index (AQI) is forecast to be 75 or higher anywhere in the state;
- When the Forest Fire Danger Index is high, very high, or extreme; and where woodland or grass land is within one hundred feet of the proposed burn;
- When there is an advisory from the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) Commissioner of any air pollution episode;
- Burning of any material other than brush;
- On property other than residential property upon which the permittee resides.

Open burning is limited to the burning of brush only, on residential property upon which the permittee resides and is subject to all of the requirements above. 2. Burning must cease if so directed by any member of the Town Fire Marshal's Office, any Officer of the Fire Department or any Official of the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection. 3. All reasonable measures to assure complete combustion and reduce excessive smoke are to be taken. 4. All reasonable safety precautions are to be taken, including the cleaning of grass and trees in the burn area, wetting down of the surrounding area, and the placement of fire extinguishers and hose lines. 5. This permit must be immediately available on site during the burn. 6. Burning may only be conducted between the hours of 10:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M. on a sunny or partly sunny day with the wind speed between five and fifteen miles per hour. 7. Violation of the terms and conditions of this permit may cause the forfeiture of your ability to qualify for a permit in the future.

Residential Guidelines For Open Burning

Permit for Open Burning are regulated by the Department of Environmental Protection and the Office of the Easton Fire Marshal.

There will be a limit of one permit per property owner during the calendar year.

No applicant other than an Easton resident or property owner may obtain a permit to burn.

The Applicant will complete a "Local Open Burning Official Application" at the Easton Fire Department, One Center, Easton, CT. Open Burning Applications are available Monday thru Saturday 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

After the application has been completed, there will be a five day waiting period, (not including Saturday & Sunday), for review of the application.

On the fifth day, the applicant may pick up the application at the Easton Fire Department.

The Open Burning Permit will be valid until the end of the current calendar year.

The applicant may burn up to four times during the calendar year.

The applicant shall call the Easton Fire Department, phone number 203-268-2833, one hour prior to burning to determine if burning will be allowed on that day. Failure to secure permission to burn is a violation of the open burning permit.

The applicant may only burn brush or shrubs, vegetation, pruning the diameter which is not greater than three inches.

The applicant may not burn garbage, paper, grass, metals, plastics, leaves, rubber, painted materials or demolition waste. Any burning of these materials is in violation of the Open Burning Regulations Connecticut General Statutes 22a-174-17 and can subject the responsible individual to arrest under Connecticut General Statute Section 23-48.
